

APPLIED LINGUISTICS SUBJECT GUIDE

SEARCHING THE BROCK LIBRARY CATALOGUE

Select the SUBJECT and/or KeyWORDS search options in the Brock Library Catalogue. Use KEYWORDS to search in several fields (title, author, subject, notes, etc) at once. Use AND, OR, NOT and truncation (*) to broaden or narrow your search. For example:

*sociolinguistics and multicultural** – will retrieve works about *sociolinguistics and multicultural, multiculturalism*, etc.

(aboriginal or native) and language* – will retrieve works about *Native peoples and language*

Use the subject headings of relevant catalogue records in a SUBJECT search to get more records. For example:

Sociolinguistics -- Canada

Native language

Language acquisition

If your search retrieves too many items, use *Modify This Search* to limit/sort your results by *Year of publication, Material type, Publisher, Location* and more.

RESERVE COLLECTION

Check RESERVES by course or by instructor in the Brock Library Catalogue.

SEARCHING LIBRARY DATABASES

Select DATABASES, then APPLIED LINGUISTICS on the Brock Library Home Page to find journal articles. Try the following:

PsycINFO

Social Science Citation Index

To find other bibliographies (i.e. lists of books, journal articles, etc.) on specific topics in linguistics, use the **KEYWORDS** search option in the Brock Library Catalogue.

e.g. *language and bibliography**

OR, using the **SUBJECT** search option, type in the subject heading followed by the word *bibliography*.

e.g. *language acquisition bibliography*
